SECOND CYCLE of REBELLION: EHUD, SHAMGAR JUDGES 3:12-31

Judges 3:12 - "...the LORD strengthened Eglon the king of Moab against Israel."

<u>Moab</u> – descendants of Abraham's nephew Lot (Gen. 19:36,37). They share the same Great -grandfather (Terah – father of Abraham) Gen 11:27.

Unique relationship with Israel; like feuding relatives, at times they were at peace and trusted by some; and at other times they were fiercely jealous/fearful/angry/Combative...never able or willing to reconcile.

Some historical notes about Moab:

God gave Moab a portion of land - Deut 2:9-12

King Balak (Moab) hired Balaam to curse Israel - Numbers 22-24

Moabite women led men of Israel to sin during exodus - Numbers 25:1,2

David trusts his parents to King of Moab - 1 Samuel 22:3,4

David executed 2/3? of the Moabites - 2 Samuel 8:2

Ruth (Moabite - Ruth 1:22) traced in David's genealogy - Matt. 1:5,6

King Eglon takes Jericho (any significance?), enslaves Israel for 18 years

The name "Eglon" incorporates the ideas of a small rotund calf/bull.

Moabites were known to have a rich, fatty diet.

The adjective used to describe the Moabite soldiers (robust/stout vs. 29) was also used of rich food, fertile land and lush pastures.

Ehud = "where is the majesty?" – The glory of Israel had faded into slavery. A Benjaminite –

Left-handed (20:16) -

"Raised up" by the Lord -

Shamgar – killed 600 Philistines with an oxgoad (cattle prod).

Question: What would "he also delivered Israel" imply?

Note: Some scholars believe Shamgar was a separate cycle himself, making 7 cycles.
